Pre-visit Information for School Groups

Thank you for planning a visit to the Leach Pottery.

Facilities

- We don't have a covered or indoors picnic area but have benches in the garden for picnics
- If planning to have lunch in our gardens please bring your own picnic. There is a Co-op a 5 minute walk from the Leach Pottery
- Please help keep the spaces at the Leach Pottery as you find them
- The teaching studios are well ventilated so please bring extra layers of warm clothing with you.
- There are toilet facilities including accessible space

Travelling & Parking

- If travelling by car or mini bus, please be aware that there is limited parking on-site. Please let us know if you require a parking reservation for your mini bus in the Leach Pottery car park. For additional cars ask that you use the overflow parking at St John's in the Fields Church (TR26 2HG) which is on the right hand side past the Leach Pottery, opposite the Fire Station, as you travel uphill. Please park in the main car park around the church by the church hall and leave a note in your car window to say you are on a course at the Pottery. Please plan your visit before arriving.
- The Leach Pottery has two dedicated disabled access parking spaces
- The closest petrol station is [Texaco, St. Erth, TR27 6JW](#), 3.3 miles from the Leach Pottery.
- St Ives bus station is a 16 minute walk from the Leach Pottery. For more information please visit www.firstbus.co.uk.
- Coaches can drop off groups on Penbeagle Lane which backs onto the Leach Pottery. Please do not use the Fire Station for turning vehicles.

The number 16 and 16A buses stop just outside Leach Pottery Beagle Cross gate: they go towards Penzance via Nancledra. Please visit www.firstgroup.com.
